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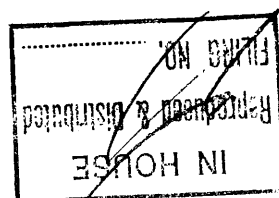
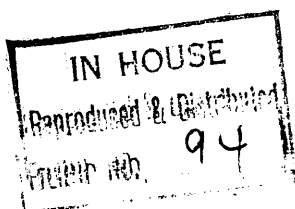
House Amendment "A" to H. P. 1531, L.D. 1114, Bill "An Act Relating to the Appointment, Term of Office and Removal of the City Clerk of the City of Lewiston."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Referendum. This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of this legislature only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the city of Lewiston at the next municipal election to be held in 1948. Such meeting shall be called for that purpose by an appropriate article inserted in the call for such meeting. The city clerk shall prepare the required ballots for the meeting upon which he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall 'An Act Relating to the Appointment, Term of Office and Removal of the City Clerk of the City of Lewiston', passed by the 93rd legislature, be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross placed over the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This act shall take effect for all the purposes of this act immediately upon the acceptance of this act by a majority of the legal voters voting at such meeting.

The result of the vote in such city shall be declared by the municipal officers thereof and a certificate thereof filed by the city clerk with the secretary of state.'
