STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Town and City Clerks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 80, § 27-A, additional. Chapter 80 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 27-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 27-A. Expenses of town clerks. The reasonable and necessary travelling expenses of clerks of cities and towns and of their employees while attending the meetings of the Maine municipal association and the Maine town and city clerks association, certified upon vouchers approved by the municipal officers, shall be paid by the treasurer of the city or town.'
