AN ACT Relating to Injurious Substances Thrown on Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 86, amended. Section 86 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'The operator or custodian of a motor vehicle shall be criminally liable if he knowingly permits any occupant of such motor vehicle to throw bottles, cans and other injurious substances on the highways of the state.'
