ORIGINAL

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 349, L. D. 1161, Bill "An Act Prohibiting
Erection of Billboards Adjacent to Turnpikes."

Amend the title of said bill by striking out the underlined
word "turnpikes" and inserting the underlined word 'highways'.

Further amend said bill by striking out the underlined word
"turnpikes" wherever it appears in said bill, and inserting in
place thereof the underlined word 'highways'

Further amend said bill by striking out the underlined word
"turnpike" in the 6th and 12th lines of said bill and inserting
in place thereof the underlined word 'highway'.

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 7th line of
said bill the underlined word "turnpike" and inserting in place
thereof the underlined word 'highways'.

Further amend said bill by adding at the end thereof a new
section as follows:

'Sec. 2. So much of section 116 of chapter 20 of the revised
statutes as is inconsistent with this act is hereby repealed.'
