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
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Senate Amendment "A" to H. P. 1606, L. D. 1272, Bill "An Act to Repeal the Charter of the Bay Point Village Corporation."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of Section 4 thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 4. Effective date; referendum. This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of this legislature only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the "Bay Point Village Corporation," at any special or annual meeting of the above mentioned corporation, which meeting shall be called within 45 days after the effective date of this, act for that purpose by an appropriate article inserted in the call for said meeting. For the purpose of . this meeting the provisions of section 11 of the private and special laws of 1925 relating to the qualification of voters is hereby amended to conform to the provisions of the following sentence. A legal voter at such meeting shall be any person of lawful age who has, since July 1, 1946, owned and been in possession of one or more lots of land within the limits of the Bay Point Village Corporation. Such meeting shall be called, advertised and conducted according to the charter of the "Bay Point Village Corporation". The clerk of the "Bay Point Village Corporation" shall prepare the required ballots upon which he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall 'An Act to Repeal the Charter of the Bay Point Village Corporation' be accepted?", and the voters shall indicate by a cross placed over the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. the vote in the said corporation shall be declared by the overseers of said corporation, and a certificate thereof filed by the clerk with the secretary of state immediately after the determination of the vote. This act shall become effective in full upon the date that the certificate of the results of the votes of the Bay Point Village Corporation is filed with the secretary of state to the property that act is accepted.'
