Committee Amendment "A" to H. P. 1628, L. D. 1300, Bill
"An Act Regulating Lights on Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by reinstating the stricken out words
"as an auxiliary light" in the 6th and 7th lines of that part
designated "Sec. 116".

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined
words "the spot light or fog or auxiliary lights may be used"
in the 7th line of that part designated "Sec. 116."

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the period
at the end thereof, the following underlined clause:

'provided, however, that the provisions of this sentence
shall not apply to vehicles used by law enforcement officers,
fire departments, ambulance drivers, or highway sanding or
snowplowing authorities'.

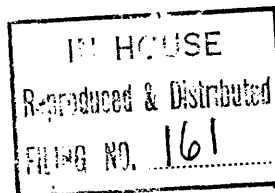
