HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1651, L. D. 1349, Bill "An Act
Relating to Tuition for Pupils from Towns
Not Maintaining a Standard Secondary School."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the second paragraph
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'In the case of any youth attending school ~~in-a-town-ether~~
~~than-the-town-of-his-residence-as-provided-for-in-this-section~~
under conditions as provided for in the preceding paragraph,
the tuition shall not exceed ~~\$125~~ \$150 annually for any one
youth, except that the tuition shall not exceed ~~\$100~~ \$125
annually for any one youth in a secondary school ~~which-has-not~~
~~maintained-a-pupil-teacher-ratio-of-at-least-15-to-1-during-the~~
~~preceeding-year,-or-an-average-pupil-teacher-ratio-of-15-to-1~~
~~during-the-preceeding-5-years,-and~~ which does not offer at least
3 courses of study, two of which shall be industrial or occupational.'
