'Any recipient of old age assistance shall be disqualified from receiving old age assistance unless he files with the commissioner, and annually thereafter during the month of December, on or before January 1, 1948, the following information:

I. A sworn statement concerning income, assets and liabilities of the recipient, sworn to by the recipient;

II. An individual sworn statement of inability to support the recipient made on the part of each accessible adult child or spouse of said recipient, and such statements shall include full information regarding individual income, assets and lia-

bilities.'
