Senate Amendment " B " to H.P. 1699, L.D. 1416, Bill "An Act Relating to Fees of Registers of Deeds."

Amend said Bill by striking out the 8th paragraph thereof, and inserting in its place the following:

'Entering in the margin of a record a discharge of the mortgage or attachment to be signed by the person discharging it, 25¢;'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the next to the last paragraph thereof and inserting in its place the following:

'In all cases where books with printed forms are not furnished therefor, registers of deeds shall receive for receiving, filing, and recording any instrument by law entitled to record, the sum of \$1 for the first 500 words, and the sum of 20¢ for each 100 words or fraction thereof in excess of 500 words.'
