HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to H. P. 1731, L. D. 1470, Bill "An Act Imposing
a Sales and Use Tax to Raise Additional Revenue."

Amend said Bill by striking out the figure "2%" wherever it
appears therein, and inserting in place thereof the figure '1%'.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all that part
designated "Sec. 356" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 356. Disposition of proceeds. The entire proceeds of
this tax shall be credited to the general fund.'
