HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 547, L. D. 1484, Bill "An Act Relating
to Veteran's Permit to Hunt and Fish Free."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof *the following:*

'The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is here-
by authorized to issue free veteran's fishing permits cover-
ing groups of mental patients undergoing rehabilitation
training at the Veteran's Administration Center at Togus.
These permits shall be issued on request of the manager
of the Veteran's Administration Center at Togus, shall
be effective while such groups are being conducted by a
representative of the Veteran's Administration and while
such groups are fishing within a 5 mile radius of Togus.'
