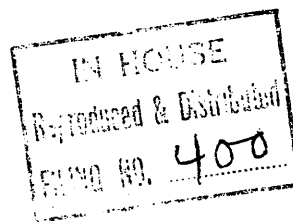
House Amendment " *H* " to H. P. 1742, L. D. 1489, Bill "An Act Imposing a Personal Income Tax to Raise Additional Revenue and Equalize the Tax Burden."

Amend said Bill by adding after subsection III of that part <sup>underlined</sup> designated "Sec. 249" of section 1 thereof a new/subsection to be numbered IV, to read as follows:

'IV. In the case of a veteran who has served in the armed forces of the United States during the federally recognized period of World War II, who was honorably discharged, or who was separated from such service under conditions other than dishonorable, \$1,500.!
