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**AN ACT Limiting the Apportionment of State Funds for State Aid Roads.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 20, § 27, amended.** Section 27 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 128 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

**'No apportionment or payment of state funds under the provisions of this section shall be made to any city or town which makes a charge in excess of the payments from those parking motor vehicles to meet the cost of the installation, operation and maintenance of any device or facility.'**
