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**AN ACT Relating to Board of Registration of Nurses.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 63, § 3, amended.** The last paragraph of section 3 of chapter 63 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘The examination to be given shall include those areas deemed by the board necessary to adequately evaluate the applicants’ ability to practice professional nursing. Any applicant passing said examination to the satisfaction of the board shall receive a certificate of registration within 3 months of said examination.’

**Sec. 2. Amendatory clause.** Wherever in the revised statutes or public laws the words “board of registration of nurses” appear they shall mean ‘Maine board of nursing’.
