STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Shipping of Clams, Quahogs and Mussels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 95, amended. The 1st sentence of section 95 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person, firm or corporation shall, between the 1st day of June and the 1st day of October following, ship, transport, offer for shipment or transportation either directly or indirectly any clams, quahogs or mussels either in the shell or shucked ~~taken from the clam flats of Washington, Hancock, Knox and Waldo counties~~ beyond the limits of the state ~~and/or to the counties of Sagadahoc, Cumberland, Lincoln and York~~; provided, however, that an exception shall be made to clams, quahogs or mussels which have been canned, packed or barreled between the 1st day of October and the 1st day of June.'
