**AN ACT Relating to Definition of "Employer" Under Unemployment
Compensation Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 24, § 19, sub-§ (f), ¶ (1), amended. Paragraph (1) of subsection (f) of section 19 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'(1) Any employing unit which for some portion of a day, but not necessarily simultaneously, in each of 20 different weeks, whether or not such weeks are or were consecutive, within either the current or the preceding calendar year, has or had in employment, 8 1 or more individuals (irrespective of whether the same individuals are or were employed in each such day);'
