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**AN ACT Designating the Counties of Maine on Motor Vehicle Registration  
Plates.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 19, § 17, amended.** The 2nd sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 17 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Such plates shall be of a distinctly different color or shade each year and shall be in such form as the secretary of state may determine; and shall bear the numerals of the year of issue, or the last 2 numerals of said year, the word “Maine” or the abbreviation “Me.” in letters not less than  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch in height, and on plates issued for passenger vehicles for private use, hire cars and trucks, there shall be placed at the bottom thereof in letters not less than  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch in height the word “Vacationland” and a letter or letters designating the county in which the owner resides.’
