RESOLVE Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Taylor Pond in the city of Auburn, in the County of Androscoggin.

Outlet of Taylor pond: screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,200 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for the purpose of installing a fish screen at the outlet of Taylor pond, in the city of Auburn, in the county of Androscoggin; provided that no funds shall be expended under this resolve until some person or association raises $\frac{1}{2}$ of the above amount and the Androscoggin fish and game association agrees to keep the screen free from sticks, leaves and debris.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The purpose of this resolve is to prevent fish from going over the dam.
