**AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Anticipated Overdrafts in the State
Treasury Due to Insufficient Appropriations.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the funds appropriated for the present functions of the treasurer of state for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949 are insufficient; and

Whereas, section 4 of part fourth of article V of the constitution and sections 1, 2 and 3 of chapter 15 of the revised statutes provide for these functions as a direct obligation of the state; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Emergency appropriation. In order to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949, the following sum or as much thereof as shall be found necessary, as designated in

the following tabulation, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated:

Treasurer of state	1948-49 \$838.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
