AN ACT Relating to Trucks Transporting Pulp, Slabs and Logs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 86, amended. Section 86 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

‘No person shall operate or cause to be operated upon any public way a vehicle with a load unless such load is adequately fastened or otherwise secured or confined to prevent any portion of said load from falling to the ground. The word “load” as used in this paragraph shall include, but not limited to, firewood, pulpwood, logs, bolts or other material.’
