**AN ACT to Increase the Borrowing Capacity of the Town of Norridgewock
School District.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1933, c. 109, § 4-A, amended. Section 4-A of chapter 109 of the private and special laws of 1933, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 130 of the private and special laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 4-A. Additional funds. To procure additional funds to erect, equip, construct and maintain a school building or buildings to replace the school building destroyed in March, 1945, and for such other costs and expenses as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this act, the said district is hereby authorized to issue its bonds or notes in a total amount not to exceed the sum of ~~\$60,000~~ \$120,000, which shall be additional to and not inclusive of the indebtedness provided for in section 4. Such bonds or notes may be issued upon the same terms and in the same manner as is provided in section 4 and the provisions of sections 5 and 6 relating to sinking fund and provisions for sinking fund shall be applicable.'
