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**AN ACT Relating to Clam, Quahog and Mussel Flats.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 34, § 94, amended.** Section 94 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘Clams, quahogs and mussels, dug for any purpose in certain flats and on certain shores in the state that are not acceptable for shipment in interstate commerce but are in conformity with regulations promulgated by the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries, shall be acceptable for sale in the state.’
