STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to School Unions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 68, amended. Section 68 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 240 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

'Provided further, that on presentation of a written plan of organization which has been approved by the superintending school committees of the towns involved, the commissioner and the committee are authorized to combine 2 or more school unions, or parts thereof, into a large supervisory unit administered by a superintendent of schools and staff assistants, who may be employed by the joint committee as provided in section 70, and the commissioner shall have authority to adjust disbursements for supervision so that there will be no loss in state support because of the reorganization.'
