IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Amending Complaints and Indictments in Matters of Substance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 132, § 14, amended. The last sentence of section 14 of chapter 132 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any complaint, indictment or other criminal process for any offense, except for a capital or infamous crime felony, may be amended in matters of substance, provided the nature of the charge is not thereby changed.'
