RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Fish Pond in the County of Knox.

Fishing in Fish pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 fish per person in fishing the waters of Johnson's pond, on Appleton ridge, in the town of Appleton, county of Knox.
