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### **AN ACT Relating to Street Openings by Public Utility Corporations.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 46, § 18-B, repealed and replaced.** Section 18-B of chapter 46 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 252 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**'Sec. 18-B. Fees for excavation permits.** The municipal officers of any city or town may establish a schedule of fees for granting permits for making an excavation within the driveway of any street or highway, said schedule of fees not to exceed the reasonable cost of replacement of the excavated pavement. The applicant shall pay to the treasurer of the city or town granting such permit the fees as established by the municipal officers and all such fees shall be regularly accounted for and shall constitute a special fund for the repaving of said cuts.'
