SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 2011, L. D. 1394, Bill "An Act Relating  
to Traffic Control Signals."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of paragraph "C." at the  
end thereof.

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof a new  
subsection VI to read as follows:

'VI. Red and yellow (pedestrian signal). While the red  
and yellow lenses are illumined together, drivers shall  
not enter the intersection and the intersection shall be  
reserved for the exclusive use of pedestrians.' '
