RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Mayfield Pond in the County of Somerset.

Regulating fishing in Mayfield pond in the county of Somerset. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Mayfield pond in Brighton plantation and Mayfield township, in the county of Somerset, to fishing through the ice for pickerel, hornpout, white perch, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring and for all fish except bass during February, March and April.
