RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Ethel S. Dick, of Gardiner.

Teacher's pension granted to Ethel S. Dick. Resolved: That a special pension be, and hereby is, granted to Ethel S. Dick, of Gardiner, comparable with that paid under the teachers' noncontributory pension law, based on 25 years of teaching service, as is now or may hereafter be provided by the legislature, to be paid quarterly from the general fund. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1949 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Ethel S. Dick, of Gardiner, taught in the public schools of Maine for 22 years, up to 1944. She also taught as a substitute, but no records are available as to her individual service as a substitute teacher, the records showing only that a "substitute teacher" was employed.
