STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of New Portland.

Town of New Portland; appropriation for. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of the town of New Portland by the 93rd legislature for the fiscal years 1947-48 and 1948-49 for repairing the Wire Bridge road, so called, leading from West New Portland to Stanley Perkins' corner, so called, be and hereby is reappropriated for repairing the George Safford road, so called, to be expended for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The appropriation made by the 93rd legislature was supposed to have been for the George Safford road and through error was given to the Wire Bridge road.
