RESOLVE, in Favor of Erskine Academy.

Erskine Academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$25,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund to be expended by Erskine Academy toward the enlargement of its school buildings to furnish school privileges to the youth of China, Windsor, North Whitefield, Jefferson, Washington and Palermo.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These buildings were originally built to take care of from 60 to 70 pupils. In 1936, it was enlarged to care for 115 pupils. The present enrollment is 163 and the facilities are not adequate to accommodate the present student body.
