STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Athens.

Town of Athens; reappropriation of money. Resolved: That the sum of \$400 appropriated in favor of the town of Athens by the 93rd legislature for the repairing of the road known as Set Off be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended in the ensuing fiscal years on the Stickney Hill, so called.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This money was not used on the road known as Set Off and it is desired to have said money reappropriated to be used on Stickney Hill.
