SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 654, L. D. 1447, Bill "An Act Amending  
An Act to Provide for the Joining of Towns for  
the Purpose of Providing Better School Facil-  
ities."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the title and before the en-  
acting clause the following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, certain community secondary school  
districts have already been formed under general law to provide for  
adequate secondary school buildings and instruction; and

Whereas, specifications for such buildings have been drafted and  
such districts are prepared to proceed with construction and mainten-  
ance of community secondary school instruction; and

Whereas, bond underwriters have refused approval of the issue of  
bonds of community secondary school districts organized under the  
present law; and

Whereas, the within legislation is vitally necessary to prevent  
great hardship to the youth of the state for lack of school buildings  
and suitable instruction; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create  
an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and re-  
quire the following legislation as immediately necessary for the pres-  
ervation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by striking out the first 2 lines of sec-  
tion 8 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 8. Emergency clause; effective date; limitation. In view  
of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect  
when approved; provided, '
