HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 2042, L. D. 1465, Bill, "An Act Relating to Automobile Travel by State Employees"

Amend said bill by striking out all of the first sentence of that part designated "Sec. 28" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:

'The state shall pay for the use of privately owned automobiles for travel by employees of the state in the business of the state at the rate of 6¢ per mile; provided, however, that the state shall pay inspectors of seed potatoes 7¢ for every mile so traveled.'
