## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in the Fish River Chain of Lakes.

Fishing in the Fish River Chain of Lakes, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing all the waters of the Fish River Chain of Lakes, in the county of Aroostook to plug or still fishing in more than 25 feet of water from July 15 to September 1.
