RESOLVE, in Favor of George S. Bradbury, of West Franklin.

George S. Bradbury; increase in retirement benefit. Resolved: That George S. Bradbury receive an increase in the amount of retirement benefit which he is presently receiving under the provisions of the Maine state retirement law in the amount of \$42.70 per month, the same to be paid from the funds of the Maine state retirement system.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. George S. Bradbury was formerly employed by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game and retired due to disability on October 24, 1949 at the age of 60 on a monthly retirement benefit based on his years of service of \$57.30.

Mr. Bradbury served the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game for approximately eighteen and two-thirds years.

His disability prevents him from engaging in any gainful occupation and it is desired to increase his monthly retirement benefit to the amount of \$100.
