HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1485, L. D. 1092, Bill "An Act Relating  
to Sale of Liquor Near Togus Hospital."

Amend said Bill by striking out all after the enacting clause  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 57, Sec. 70, amended. Section 70 of the revised  
statutes, as amended by the public laws of 1949, is hereby further  
amended to read as follows:

'Whoever sells or gives away any liquor at any place within 1  
mile from the public entrances of the Togus hospital, except the  
legal sale of malt beverages in retail stores, upon conviction shall  
pay a fine of not less than \$25, nor more than \$100, and in addition  
thereto shall be imprisoned for a term of 30 days; and on conviction  
of the owner or keeper thereof the place wherein such intoxicating  
liquor shall have been sold or given away shall be, by order of the  
court wherein such conviction is made, within 10 days thereafter,  
closed and abated as a nuisance. It is made the duty of the county  
attorney of the county of Kennebec to prosecute all offenders against  
the provisions of this section.'
