STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Emergency Lights on Police and Fire Department Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 34, amended. The last paragraph of section 34 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The provisions of this chapter governing the equipment or use of front lights on motor vehicles shall not apply to motor vehicles owned or controlled by municipalities or village corporations and used for police and fire fighting purposes; or to motor vehicles operated by chiefs and deputy chiefs of police and by chiefs and assistant chiefs of fire departments.'
