HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 467, L. D. 1100, Bill "An Act to Control and Eradicate Bang's Disease."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following emergency preamble:

'<u>Emergency preamble</u>. Whereas, Bang's disease, or what is commonly known as contagious abortion, is a serious menace to the cattle industry of the state; and

Whereas, immediate action is necessary to check the spread of this disease to protect not only the cattle industry but also the health of the people; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following:

'<u>Emergency clause</u>. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.'
