RESOLVE, in Favor of Hampden Academy.

Hampden academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Hampden academy, the sum of \$30,000 to be taken from the general fund of the state to build a gymnasium for said Hampden academy.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A gymnasium would provide an apportunity to make available to all the students of the academy a full program of physical education. It would also provide a much needed place for school assemblies, dramatics, etc. The town cannot erect such a building without some assistance.
