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**AN ACT Relating to Superintending School Committees.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 50-B, additional.** Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 50-B, to read as follows:

**‘Sec. 50-B. Decisions of school committees; limitations. Upon petition of at least 10% of the legal voters of a city, town or plantation, a special town meeting shall be called for the purpose of voting to affirm, veto or alter any decision of the superintending school committee.’**
