STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Superintending School Committees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 50-B, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 50-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 50-B. Decisions of school committees; limitations. Upon petition of at least 10% of the legal voters of a city, town or plantation, a special town meeting shall be called for the purpose of voting to affirm, veto or alter any decision of the superintending school committee.'
