AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Dumping Waste Material in Public Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 124, § 24, amended. Section 24 of chapter 124 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 24. Dumping waste material in public ways; penalty. Whoever deposits or dumps refuse or waste material of any kind within the limits of any public way, except upon written authority of the municipal officers, shall be punished by a fine of not more than ~~\$10~~ \$20 ~~to be recovered to the use of the town where the offense is committed.~~'
