COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1531, L. D. 1124, Bill "An Act  
Relating to Clearance Markings on Railroad  
and State Highway Overpasses"

Amend said bill by striking out "7-A" wherever it occurs and  
inserting '7-M' in place thereof.

Further amend said bill by adding at the end of the second  
paragraph thereof, the following underlined sentences: 'The same  
requirements shall apply to highway bridges when the vertical  
underclearance is limited by the portal, bracing or other  
structural members. This section shall apply only when the  
vertical clearance is less than 14 feet 6 inches. The clearance  
indicated is to be the normal summer clearance.'

Further amend said bill by inserting after the underlined  
words "railroad overpasses" in the second line of the paragraph  
lettered "93-A" the underlined words, 'which pass over highways',  
and by adding at the end of said paragraph the following under-  
lined words,

'This section shall apply only when the vertical clearance is  
less than 14 feet 6 inches. The clearance indicated is to be the  
normal summer clearance.'
