**RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at the Outlet of Gardner's Lake
at Chase's Mills, in East Machias, Washington County.**

Gardner's lake; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$400 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Gardner's lake at Chase's Mills, in East Machias, Washington county; provided, however, that Gardner's Lake Fish and Gun Club shall assume all liability for maintaining said screen and keeping said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further, that the state shall be liable for only $\frac{1}{2}$ the cost of said screen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A screen was built in 1937 and is now badly in need of repair.
