AN ACT Relating to Swan Island Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 128, amended. That part of section 128 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, which relates to Swan Island Game Preserve, Game Farm, and Game Management Area, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Swan Island Game Management Area: Is shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, trap, kill or pursue any wild animals or birds above highwater mark within the following described tract or territory situated in the county of Sagadahoc, to wit; The islands in the Kennebec river, near Richmond, known as Swan island and Little Swan island (formerly known as Alexander islands). Such game management area, being bordered by tidal flats, shall be regulated by the commissioner to the high water mark on said flats.
