RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Little Jim Pond, Franklin County.

Little Jim pond; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Little Jim pond, situated in Jim Pond township, county of Franklin, for trolling with anything for bait except fish, with a daily bag limit of 6 fish or 4 pounds, per person.
