IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE in Favor of Helen G. McShea, of Fort Fairfield.

Helen G. McShea; state pension increased. Resolved: That Helen G. McShea, of Fort Fairfield, be granted an annual pension of \$900, to be paid monthly; provided, however, that, as she is now receiving a state pension, the amount named herein shall be in lieu thereof and not in addition thereto.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Helen G. McShea served as a teacher for more than 25 years. In 1947, she became totally disabled under established eligibility to a maximum annual pension under statutory provisions of \$434.76. Since that time, she has exhausted her life savings and, in addition, has lost the services of a relative who lived with her. Being entirely dependent, as a paralytic, she needs constant care. Her present pension is most inadequate to provide essential medical aid and the ordinary necessities of life.
