AN ACT Relating to Annual Reports of Certain County Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269-B, additional. Chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 269-B, to read as follows:

'Annual Reports

Sec. 269-B. Annual statements to be filed. Every judge of probate, sheriff, deputy sheriff, register of deeds and register of probate, judges, clerks and recorders of municipal courts on or before April 1st of each year shall file with the secretary of state a statement of his income as such officer for the preceding year. Such statement shall be under oath, shall show the income and operating expenses from each type of work, such as salary, court attendance, criminal investigation, service of civil process, recording fees, etc., and whether the same is for services, mileage or expenses. Said statements when filed with the secretary of state shall be open to the inspection of any interested parties.'
