HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1617, L. D. 1177, "Resolve, Regulating  
Fishing in Round Pond and Fry Pan Pond,  
Somerset County."

Amend said Resolve by striking out the period at the end  
thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:

'; and be it further

Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game  
be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and  
regulation establishing a daily bag limit of  $7\frac{1}{2}$  pounds of fish per  
person from Moose river from Brassua dam to Moosehead lake.'
